Assalamu Alaikum,

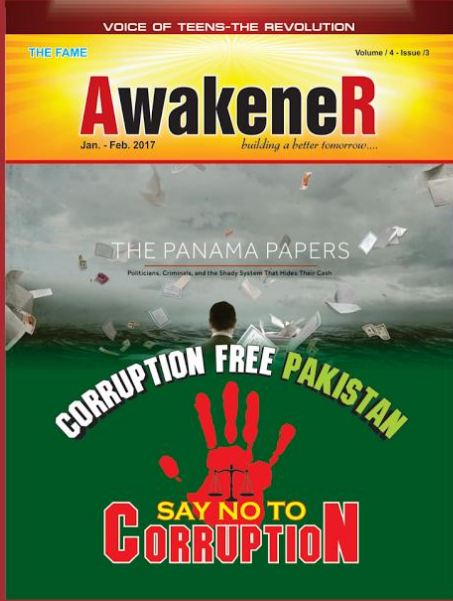
Winter vacations are now over and most of you are back to classrooms and we would like to take this opportunity to wish each and every reader a very happy new year 2017.

# ENERGY CRISES IN PAKISTAN



Energy crisis can be defined: Increase in demand of energy - electricity, gas, oil - and decrease in supply. Pakistan is an agriculture country and most of its exports are related to this sector. More than fifty percent of the total population is directly related to agriculture. The boom in development of agriculture apparatus has increased their use in Pakistani agriculture as well. Nowadays, tube-wells are powered by electricity. Crops require water to grow and farmers use tube-well to water their crops. But the energy crisis has rendered these modern technological advancements useless, as there is not enough power to operate

them.

Pakistan textile industry, which accounts for 64% of Pakistan imports, is the worst affected among other industries. The production of textile mills has been limited to only 40% of the total production capacity because of the prevalent energy crises. Pakistan will have to adopt both, long-term and short-term, solutions for economic progress. In short-term solution, Pakistan needs to exempt all Industrial units of load-shedding so that they could manufacture products up to their capacity.



# Energy Crises

Energy means "power to work". It is the power which is used to do certain things. Every work is dependent upon energy for its working. Crises means a deficiency of energy because of which walk of life stops. So energy crises means shortage of energy.

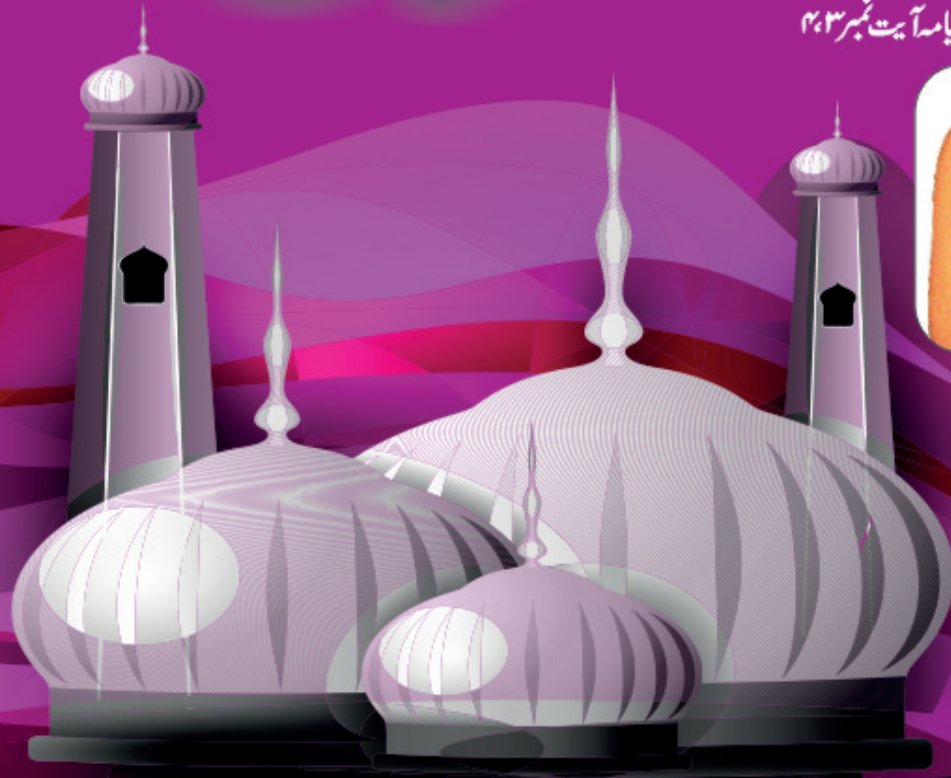

The deep sea is in black and is colder than a refrigerator, but these are the perfect conditions for some marine creatures. The scottish mountain Ben Nevis is 4, 409 feet (1,344 meters) high. Three of these mountains on top of each other would it under the sea.

**How do sharks find their food?**

Sharks can smell blood in the water hundreds of yards away. They can also sense the small amounts of electricity that are given off by all living things. Some species of sharks have extra row of teeth so if some of their teeth wear away, they have backups!

**How do plants survive in the desert?**

All living things need water in order to survive, Desert plants get water through their roots, which

## INTERVIEW WITH PAKISTAN'S FIRST-EVER FEMALE SECTION OFFICER

## FAHMIDA ABBASI

Taking charge in every field, coming from all walks of life; women have proved themselves to be worthy and efficient enough to take control.

Pakistan has been lucky enough in this regard that we have women writers, teachers, doctors, engineers - we even had our First woman Prime Minister to head a Muslim majority nation. And, to add one more jewel to the list, we now have Pakistan's First-Ever Female section officer, Fahmida Abbasi.

**Q:** Madam, we feel great pleasure and honour to meet you and would like to thank you for taking out some time from your busy schedule for this interview. Madam, first of all we would like to have your introduction for our readers so please, tell us something about yourself.

**A:** My name is Fahmida Abbasi. I am DSP here at licensing branch Nazimabad. It has been 6 months

since I got my posting here. I joined in the 90's as a police inspector and with time got promoted to the level of DSP and currently waiting for my next promotion as SP. I've worked at police administrative wings at number of stations.

**Q:** Madam, you became the pride of Pakistan when you held the position of Pakistan's first ever female section officer- how did it feel and what was the experience like?

**A:** It was quite challenging as women do not opt for this post due to its difficult nature. It is a job of great responsibility, as heavy sections such as Mai kolachi, Jinnah Branch, Akhter colony and Kaala Pul were under my supervision. They are heavy traffic areas and they are busy areas which are difficult specially when you have to deal with road management, control the flow of traffic, to deal with traffic violence and also to punish the



violator.

**Q: Tell us about a typical day at Driving License Office.**

**A:** Here at Driving License office, Nazimabad branch, I am in charge of all the work that is being done on a regular basis. Around 800-1200 people come here for their driving license, out of which 600 licenses are issued; both private and commercial, learning and permanent license as well. My duties include management of whole branch and supervision of staff which is around 100 in number, to keep a check and balance on work efficiency problem dealing and to make sure the convenience of people who come for their license.

**Q: Was choosing this profession a childhood dream or it happened as a coincidence?**

**A:** I was inspired to become a police officer by my grandfather who himself was a SHO. I distinctly remember I was in grade 5, around 10 years old when I decided for myself that I would follow my grandfather's footsteps, and by the time I got done with my intermediate and then graduation it was a time when women police force started to flourish. I was offered a job at the educational sector for teaching but I refused as I was adamant to join the Police Force.

**Q: Tell us about your initial days and experience when you were new to this profession.**

**A:** I remember being young, naive and only 23 years of age when I signed up for my first training. It was very difficult and seemed quite impossible in the beginning because the training was very tough. Back in days, we used to have all male trainers and only one female trainer.

During initial days of my service, I was asked to search through a burnt dead body of a young female for investigation purpose. The experience was something that I could not forget for days. But with time I got strength and courage and after years of service I've become very strong.

**Q: Speaking of strength and courage, what advice would you like to give to young generation especially women who hesitate stepping into the**

**competitive world?**

**A:** With advancement of age it has become a lot better for young generation especially girls to aim high in their life. It has always been my motive to make position for women better at this particular profession and therefore I encourage girls to work hard, focus on their aim so that they become successful in their lives.

**Q: How important it is in your opinion to inculcate a sense of traffic rules and regulation at school level and if it should be made a part of the curriculum?**

**A:** It is very important to teach our children about traffic rules and road signs at a young age; to inculcate a sense of traffic rules and regulations so that they can be turned into responsible citizens and drivers. Whatever inconveniences that we see on roads are usually because of lack of awareness and lack of respect for rules and a nature to abide by them. We feel that it is extremely important for school going children to know about these rules hence there is a Rehnuma Welfare help service that provides police teachers who visit schools and aware with the concepts regarding roads.

**Q: What should be the qualities of an officer?**

**A:** An officer is supposed to be punctual and be there on time for his or her duties. They should have full grasp and understanding of their work: How can you correct others when you yourself are unaware of the facts.

According to our standing order, we are to be dressed according to the dress code and it's very important to abide by these rules.

**Q: What message would you like to give to the general public as far as traffic rules are concerned?**

**A:** The most crucial aspect of road traffic is not to panic or make haste during driving. Avoid over speeding and follow the rules of traffic. Do not copy the mistakes of others thinking that you might get away with it too, in fact discourage every act which is wrong. Being a responsible citizen always pays and contribute for the welfare of general people and society. I advise everyone to be responsible and careful especially on roads.

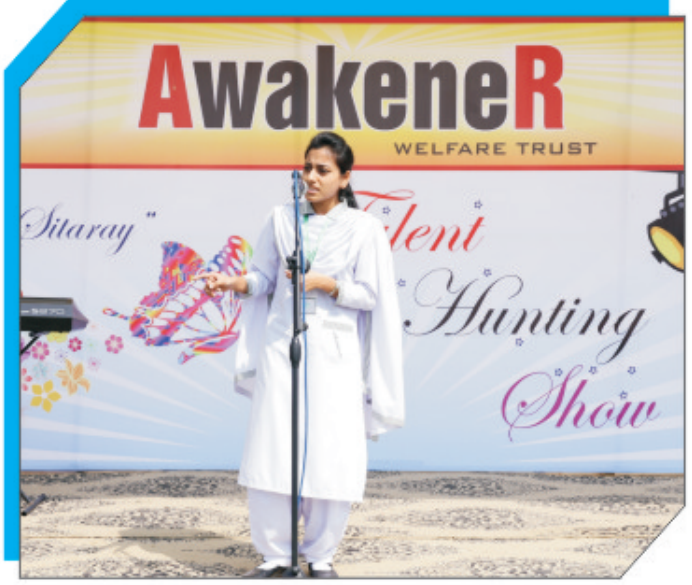


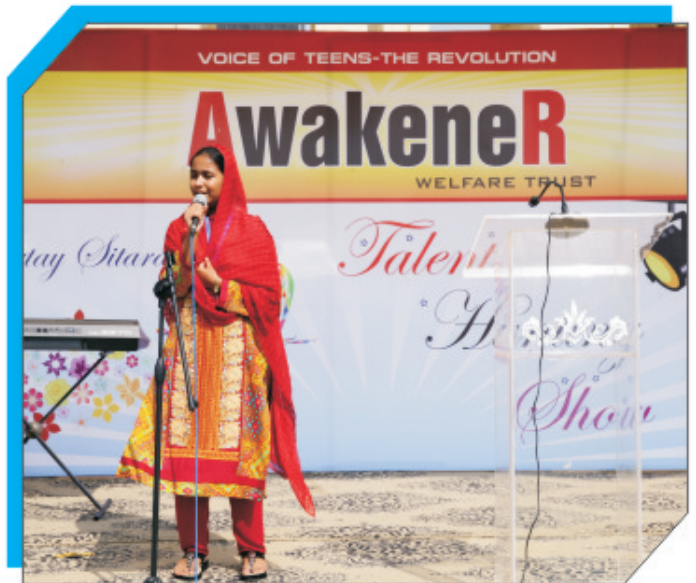

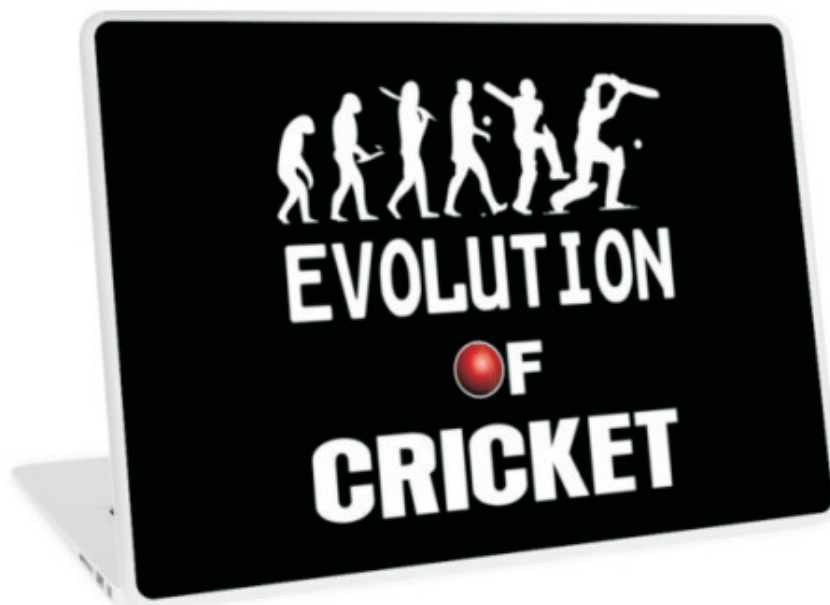

## EVOLUTION OF CRICKET

The sport of cricket began in the late 16th century in England. It is the national game of England. The cricket is 2nd most popular sport after football. It is governed by the International Cricket Council (ICC). The headquarters of the ICC is presently in Dubai. Previously, it was at London.

Cricket moved to other parts of the world in the 18th century i.e. in West Indies, India, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

A group of people founded MCC (Marylebone Cricket Club) in 1787 in England. MCC became custodian of cricket codes & laws.

International cricket began in 1877 when an England team touring Australia played two matches that are regarded as the inaugural test matches. South Africa became the third test nation in 1889. Initially only test cricket of 2 innings each was played between the countries. In the beginning, there were 4 ball over, which was replaced by 5 ball over and this was changed to six balls over in the year 1900. Later on some

countries experimented 8 balls over, but the most recent version of the cricket laws in 2000 permits only six ball over.

Pakistan gained the test status in 1951. Presently, there are 12 test playing countries.

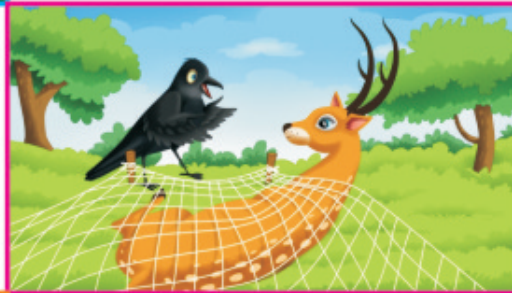
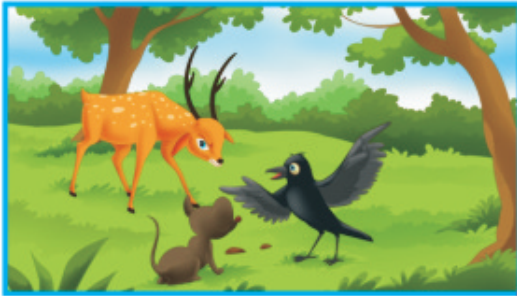
In 1960's English county teams began playing games of only one innings each and maximum number of overs per innings. The first limited overs International match played in 1971 at Melbourne as a time-filler after a test match had been abandoned due to rain, but it turned out to be a popular format. The first world cup of limited over games was played in 1975, which was won by West Indies. Pakistan also won the world cup held in the year 1992 under the captaincy of Imran khan.

Cricket's newest innovation is twenty20 matches, which has gained enormous popularity and has attracted large crowds in matches and good Television audience. The popularity of this format has been increased due to many T20 leagues in various countries.

# FRIENDSHIP

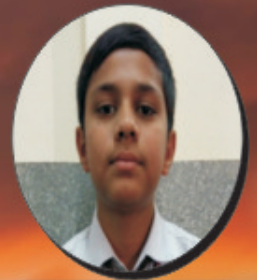
Once a deer, a crow, a mouse and a turtle were great friends.

## INTERNATIONAL HERO "ABDUL SATTAR EDHI"

### Early Life

Abdul Sattar Edhi was born on 1st January 1928 in Bantva in Gujrat, India into a Memon family. His mother gave him 1 paisa for his meal and another to give to a beggar. When he was 11, his mother became paralyzed from a stroke and she died.

When Edhi was 19, his personal experiences and care for his mother during her illness, caused him to develop a system of services for older, mentally ill and challenged people.

When Pakistan appeared on the map of the World in 14th August 1947 then Abdul Sattar Edhi migrated with his family towards Pakistan. Abdul Sattar Edhi started his life as a salesman of clothes in the wholesale market in city Karachi. After a few years, he established a free dispensary. Abdul Sattar Edhi started his dispensary from 8-by-8 room.

### Charity Work

"People have become educated, but have yet to become Human".

Edhi resolved to dedicate his life for aiding the poor and over the next sixty years, he alone changed the face of the welfare in Pakistan. Edhi established the Edhi Foundation. Since its inception, the Edhi Foundation has rescued over 20,000 infants, rehabilitated over 50,000, 40,000 nurses. It also runs more than 330 welfare centers in rural & urban Pakistan.

The Edhi Foundation, founded by Edhi, runs the World's largest ambulance service (operating 1500 of them) and offers 24 hours emergency

services. It has run relief operations in Africa, Middle East, Eastern Europe and United States where it provided aid following Hurricane Katrina in 2005. BBC wrote that he was considered "Pakistan most respected figure and was seen by some as almost a saint."

Edhi died on 8 July 2016 at the age of 88 due to Kidney failure after having been placed wishes included the request that his organs were to be donated but due to his ill health, only corneas were suitable. He was laid to rest at the Edhi Village Karachi.

There is so much we all learn from Abdul Sattar Edhi. No prize could do justice to what he was. A shining star has left all of us responsible to carry on the work he lived for. Abdul Sattar Edhi was one who would definitely restore everyone's faith in humanity; to fill his shoes will be an uphill battle.

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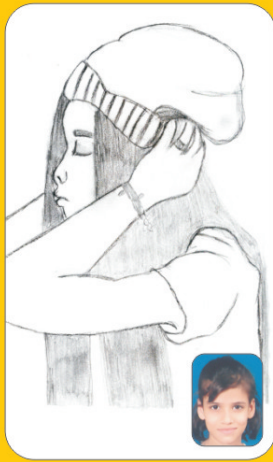

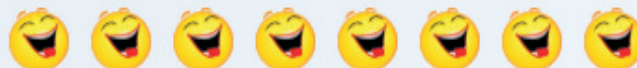
