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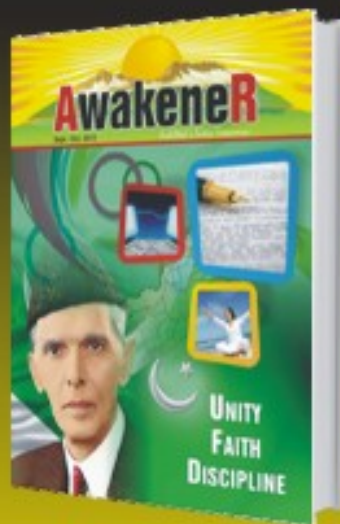
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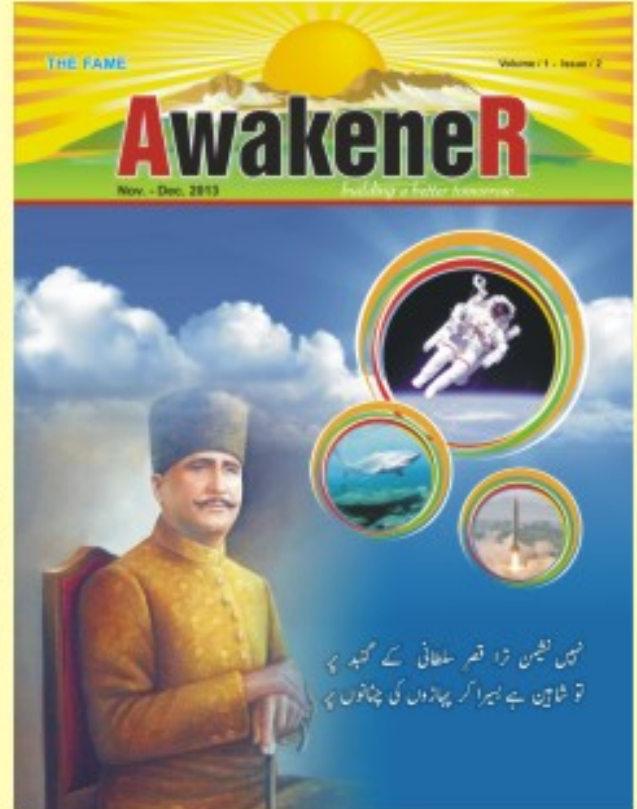

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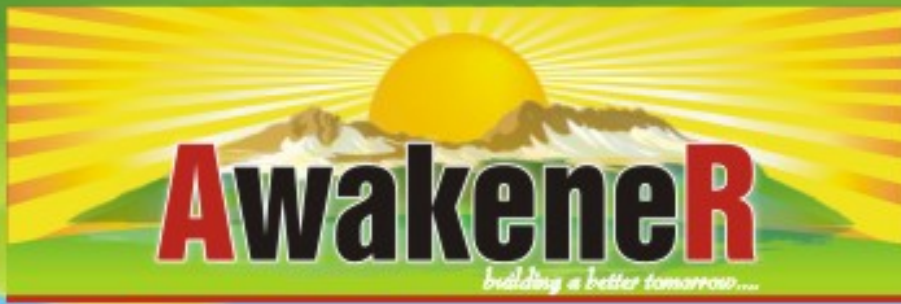
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THE QURAN

The wahi is known as Surah Alaq. The Quran got fully revealed in 23 years. The Quran has 114 Surahs, 540 rukoos and 6666 ayat. The longest surah is surah Bakra and the shortest is surah Kausar.

حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام حضرت ابراہیم علیہ السلام کے بیٹے تھے۔ آپ کی والدہ کا نام باجرہ علیہ السلام تھا۔ حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام کی شان و عظمت کا تذکرہ قرآن مجید میں اس طرح کیا گیا ہے:

”اور کتاب میں اسماعیل کا ذکر (بھی) کیجئے، بے شک وہ وعدے کے سچے اور رسول (اور) نبی تھے۔ اور اپنے گھر والوں کو نماز اور زکوٰۃ کا حکم دیتے تھے اور وہ اپنے رب کے ہاں انتہائی پسندیدہ تھے۔“

اللہ کے حکم پر اللہ کے گھر کی تعمیر اور اس کے ساتھ مکہ کا مقدس شہر بسانے کے لئے اللہ نے حضرت ابراہیم علیہ السلام اور ان کے بڑے بیٹے حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام کو منتخب کیا۔ حضرت ابراہیم علیہ السلام اپنی بیوی باجرہ علیہ السلام اور بیٹے حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام کو لے کر ایک ایسی بنجر وادی میں پہنچے جہاں نہ پانی تھا، نہ کوئی درخت، نہ کوئی پھل اور نہ کوئی خوراک تھی۔ یہ وہی جگہ تھی جو آج کل مکہ کہلاتی ہے۔ ابراہیم علیہ السلام انہیں وہاں چھوڑ کر واپس چلے گئے۔ باجرہ علیہ السلام جانتی تھیں کہ ان کے شوہر نے یہ کام اپنی مرضی سے نہیں بلکہ اللہ کے حکم کے تحت کیا ہے، اس لیے انہیں یقین تھا کہ اللہ تعالیٰ انہیں اور ان کے بیٹے کو بے یار و مددگار اور بے وسیلہ نہیں چھوڑے گا، ان کے لئے ضرور کوئی بندوبست کر دے گا، واقعی اللہ تعالیٰ نے انہیں مایوس نہ کیا۔ سب سے پہلے یہ ہوا کہ اللہ نے ان کے لئے زمین سے پانی کا ایک چشمہ نکال دیا۔ آج اس بابرکت پانی کو آب زم زم کے نام سے یاد کیا جاتا ہے۔ یہ پانی مکہ کی پوری آبادی کے علاوہ دنیا بھر سے آئے ہوئے لاکھوں حاجیوں کو سیراب کرتا ہے بلکہ حجاج کریم یہ پانی لاکھوں بلکہ کروڑوں گیلیوں کی مقدار میں دنیا بھر میں لے کر بھی جاتے ہیں۔

زم زم کے نمودار ہونے کے بعد وہ دونوں ماں بیٹا وہیں زندگی بسر کرنے لگے، کچھ عرصے بعد قبیلہ بجرم کے چند افراد قریب سے گزرے۔ انہوں نے وہاں پانی کا چشمہ دیکھا تو اس کا پانی خوب سیر ہو کر بیا، پھر انہوں نے اس جگہ کو موزوں پا کر باجرہ علیہ السلام سے اجازت مانگی کہ کیا ہم بھی آپ کے پاس زم زم کے قریب آباد ہو سکتے ہیں؟ ان کی طرف سے اجازت ملنے پر وہ یہاں رہنے لگے۔ جب حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام پل کر جوان ہو گئے تو انہوں نے اسی قبیلے کی ایک دوشیزہ کے ساتھ شادی کر لی۔

یہ حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام ہی تھے جن کے بارے میں اللہ تعالیٰ نے ان کے والد اپنے نبی حضرت ابراہیم علیہ السلام کو خواب میں حکم دیا تھا کہ وہ انہیں اللہ کی راہ میں قربان کر دیں۔ جب انہوں نے اپنے بیٹے سے ذکر کیا کہ میں نے خواب میں دیکھا ہے کہ تمہاری قربانی دے رہا ہوں۔ اس پر تمہارا کیا خیال ہے؟ حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام نے فوراً سر تسلیم خم کیا اور خود کو قربانی کے لئے پیش کر دیا۔ قرآن مجید نے اس کا ذکر اس طرح کیا ہے:

”پھر جب وہ (حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام) ان (حضرت ابراہیم علیہ السلام) کے ساتھ دوڑنے بھاگنے (کی عمر) کو پہنچے تو انہوں نے کہا: اے میرے پیارے بیٹے! بے شک میں خواب دیکھتا ہوں کہ میں تمہیں ذبح کر رہا ہوں، اب تم دیکھ لو!

اس طرح یہ قربانی آئندہ آنے والی تمام نسلوں کے لئے مثال بن گئی۔ اللہ کے نیکو کار بندے ہمیشہ اس پر عمل کرتے رہے اور کرتے ہیں اور کرتے رہیں گے۔ حضرت اسماعیل علیہ السلام نے اپنے والد کے ساتھ مل کر کعبہ کی تعمیر بھی کی۔ اس مبارک کام کو کرتے ہوئے دونوں نے ایک عظیم الشان دعا کی جس کا ایک حصہ یہ ہے۔

”اے ہمارے رب! تو ہم سے (یہ نیکو) قبول کر لے، بے شک تو ہی خوب سننے والا، خوب جاننے والا ہے۔“

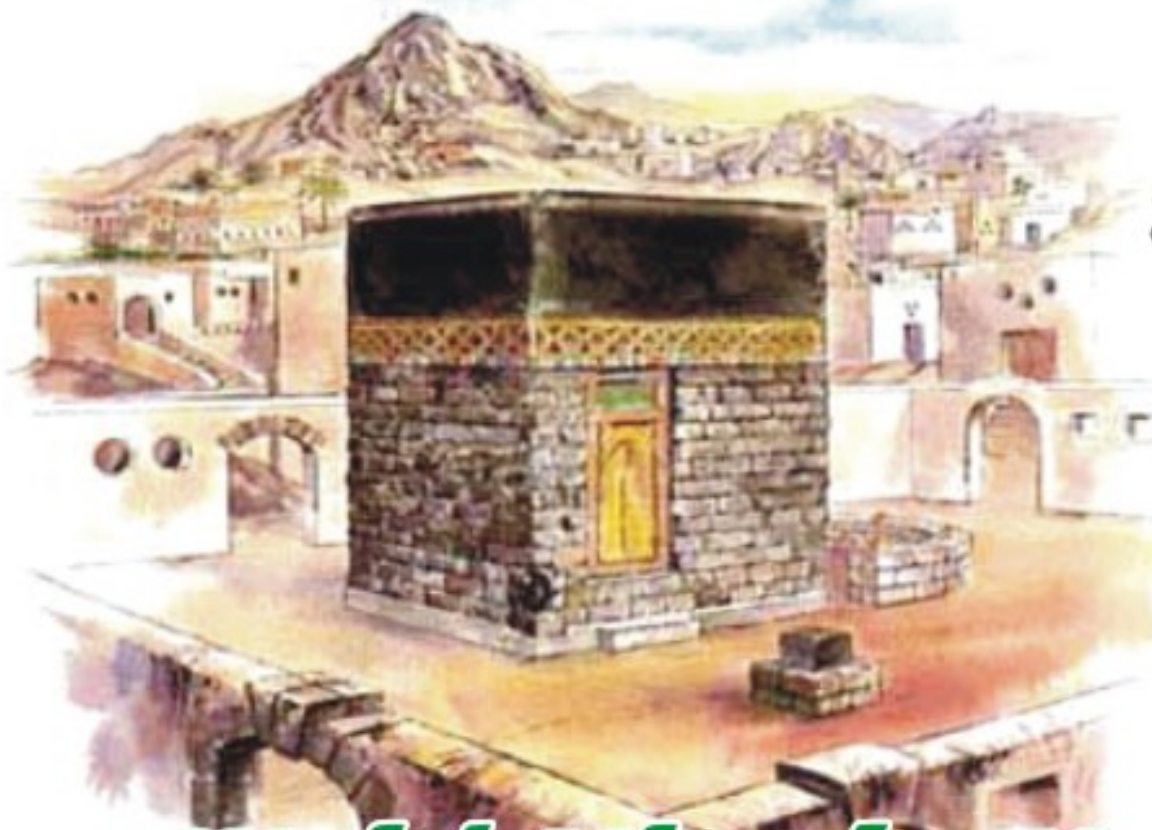

Wohi Khuda Ha !

Adam opened his eyes and looked into the beautiful face of a woman gazing down at him. Adam was surprised and asked the woman why she had been created. She revealed that she was to ease his loneliness and bring tranquillity to him. The Angels questioned Adam. They knew that Adam possessed knowledge of things they did not know about and the knowledge mankind would need to occupy the earth. They said 'who is this?' and Adam replied 'this is Eve'.

Eve is Hawwa in Arabic; it comes from the root word hay, meaning living. Eve is also an English variant of the old Hebrew word Havva, also deriving from hay. Adam informed the Angels that Eve was so named because she was made from a part of him and he, Adam, was a living being. Both Jewish and Christian traditions also maintain that Eve was created from Adam's rib, although in

a literal translation of the Jewish tradition, rib is sometimes referred to as side.

"And God said: 'O Mankind! Be dutiful to your Lord, Who created you from a single person (Adam) and from Him (Adam) He created his wife (Eve), and from them both He created many men and women.'" (Quran 4:1)

The traditions of Prophet Muhammad Peace be upon him relate that Eve was created while Adam was sleeping from his shortest left rib and that, after sometime, she was clothed with flesh. He (Prophet Muhammad Peace be upon him) used the story of Eve's creation from Adam's rib as a basis for imploring people to be gentle and kind to women. "O Muslims! I advise you to be gentle with women, for they are created from a rib, and the most crooked portion of the rib is its upper part. If you try to straighten it, it will break, and if

you leave it, it will remain crooked; so I urge you to take care of the women." (Saheeh Al-Bukhari)

DWELLING IN PARADISE

Adam and Eve dwell in tranquillity in Paradise. This, too, is agreed upon by Islamic, Christian and Jewish traditions. Islam tells us that all of Paradise was theirs to enjoy and God said to Adam, "eat both of you freely with pleasure and delight of things therein as wherever you will..." (Quran 2:35) The Quran does not reveal the exact location of where this Paradise was; however, commentators agree that it is not on the earth, and that the knowledge of the location is of no benefit to mankind. The benefit is in understanding the lesson from the events that took place there. God continued his instructions to Adam and Eve by warning them "...come not near this tree or you both will be of the wrongdoers." (Quran 2:35) The Quran does not reveal what type of tree it was; we have no details and seeking such knowledge also produces no benefit. What is understood is that Adam and Eve lived a tranquil existence and understood that they were forbidden to eat from the tree. However, Satan was waiting to exploit the weakness of mankind.

WHO IS SATAN?

Satan is a creature from the world of the Jinn. The Jinn are a creation of God made from fire. They are separate and different from both the Angels and mankind; however, like mankind, they possess the power of reason and can choose between good and evil. The Jinn existed before the creation of Adam and Satan was the most righteous among them, so much so that he was elevated to a high position amongst the Angels. "The Angels prostrated themselves all of them together. Except Satan, he refused to be among the prostrators. God said: 'O Satan! What is your reason for not being among the prostrators?' Satan said: 'I am not the one to prostrate myself to a human being, whom You created from sounding clay of altered black smooth mud.' PAKISTAN ATOMIC BOMB



India first nuclear test on May 18, 1974, sent shock waves through the Pakistani nation. The enemy had developed a fatal bomb. Pakistan's defence was weakened. The Government of Pakistan decided that the country would make the atomic bomb to keep the balance of power intact. Pakistani experts launched the project 760 to make the atomic bomb from uranium. Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan started work on the project in 1975. He had returned home after studying the most modern atomic technology from abroad. He installed the machinery at Kahuta which was secretly imported from



Europe because the European countries were not willing to sell it to Pakistan. This job was done by Pakistani who remained unidentified but put their lives in danger for their motherland by bringing the machinery to Pakistan. The effort bore fruit and Pakistan was able to make the atomic bomb in 1985. When India launched the second explosion, Pakistan gave a befitting reply to the enemy by making five explosions in the Chagai mountain.

Pakistan is the first atomic power of the Muslim world.

Moral Values



Individuals are not born with an ability to understand moral values and apply moral standards. As people mature, their physical, emotional, and cognitive abilities develop and so does their ability to deal with moral issues. Aristotle, an early Greek thinker who proposed one of the most influential theories of ethical thinking in the West, argued that our moral abilities which he called virtues or morally good habits, develop solely through constant practice and repetition, in the same way, he argued, humans acquire their moral abilities, when they are taught and habituated by their families and communities to think, feel and behave in morally appropriate ways. Such vitally important human values as courage, generosity, self-control, temperance, self-control, sociability, modesty, fairness or justice, are all virtues that he discussed and that he believed were acquired through this kind of habituation. Recently, a considerable number of thinkers have returned to Aristotle's views, although this extreme view was accepted by few philosophers, still a large number have begun to devote considerable energy to analyzing human values and some have produced analyses of great importance of the moral values that people should develop such as integrity, public-spiritedness, perseverance, veracity, fidelity, benevolence, and humility.

A sense of personal freedom is topping my list of values. When I mention 'freedom' of course I do not imply with this word all-permissiveness and universal anarchy. In my understanding freedom more refers to state of mind not strained by any external factors. I value freedom because it gives me an opportunity to fully realize myself and it depends only on my decisions and my actions what kind of a person I am going to become. Personal freedom makes it easier for me disclose my potential and to make myself a better member of the society in which I live.

Another value that is very important for me is honesty. When you're being honest with people, generally they are trying to be honest with you, so it makes the communication process much easier. I abhor the idea of lying to people just for the purpose of reaching your own goals. Even when he or she succeeds I do not think there can be felt a whole lot of satisfaction from the accomplishment based on lies. Maybe I am sounding too idealistic but I strongly believe that our society would be much better if only people became more honest to

each other. Primarily, the issue of honesty is concerned with politics and often we can see many crude and brutal crimes made against humanity, which could have been prevented if from the very start people were not deluded by the politicians' dishonesty.

Next I would like to mention is tolerance. It is a key value to develop because no matter what are your personal views and attitudes you are a part of a society, and you have to learn how to comport oneself with the members of that society. Developing a great amount of tolerance for people you associate with is always imperative and only when you are initially tolerant to people their behavior will become clearer to you, so eventually your tolerance will be gratified. For me both as person and a citizen of my nation loyalty value is also vitally important. In a narrow sense loyalty can be best viewed as how you treat your friends. Sometimes all of us hear stories when friends betray each other for the sake of money, power, women, etc. For me such behavior is completely unthinkable. When you betray someone who trusted you it is like betraying a part of yourself. But how can you call a person who betrayed his or her culture or nation? Such things are measured on a large scale now, but the essence is the same: the lack of loyalty.

And the last but certainly not least value I ought to mention is a strong feeling of family ties. Everything starts with the family. When you devour your family you devour yourself and all of your other values become meaningless. You cannot progress anywhere in your development unless you have a strong, caring relationship with the people that are closest to you. On the other hand when your family values are strong you have a solid base for improving as a person.

To conclude, I would like to say that many of my views and attitudes may be constantly changing throughout my life but my core values will always remain essentially the same. You have to have something solid down there in your soul to build upon-that's what the core values are all about. If you lose those values-you lose your sense of living, you become empty. The philosophy that I always try to follow is to become a better person, and my strong personal values are an indispensable tool for this task.

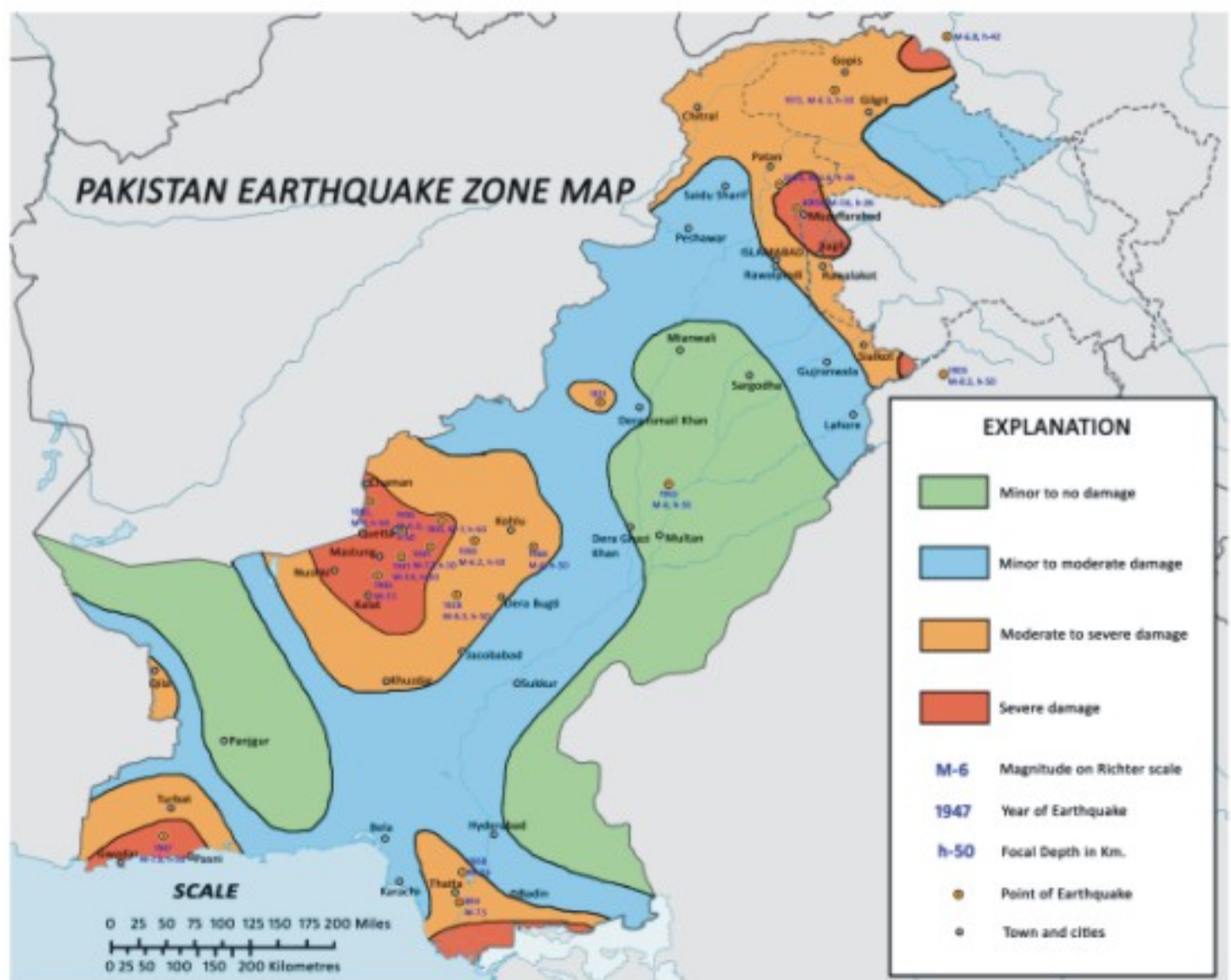

“HUMAN AND TECHNOLOGY'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE NATURAL DISASTERS”

Right from the word 'GO' (Kun in Arabic), this world is experiencing drastic and revolutionary alterations where new chapters of glories and hopes of inventions, discoveries, explorations and innovations are blossoming at every instant but we can never neglect the dark side of the picture where these boons and bounties are also acting as a gigantic problem creating disorders and disasters.

Sometimes it is assumed that natural disasters are caused by the negative deeds of the locality and we find an example of it in our religion where whole nation was turned upside down due to the negative practical knowledge of Astrology. Some of such factors are mentioned below:

"Human activity can certainly interfere with nature, which in turn may either cause a natural



disaster or make its effects much worse. "For example, human do not cause earthquakes that are generated by tectonic movement and seismic activity, but underground mining can result in instability that causes earthquakes "Humans also do not create the weather patterns that cause droughts, but unwise agricultural practices and deforestation most certainly exacerbate the effects of a drought, leading to increased desertification

"Human deeds contribute in the natural disaster "God's wrath.

"Technology gives a huge contribution in natural disaster.

Pakistan: A home to Earthquake!

Earthquake activity in Pakistan is mainly concentrated in the north and western sections of the country, along the boundary of the Indian plate and the Iranian and Afghan micro-plates. The Chaman Fault runs along Pakistan's western frontier with Afghanistan from Kalat, in the northern Makran range, past Quetta and then on to Kabul, Afghanistan. A fault also runs along the Makran coast and is believed to be of the same nature as the West Coast fault along the coast of Maharashtra, India. An active subduction zone exists off the Makran coast.

This zone forms the boundary between the

Arabian and the Iranian micro-plate, where the former subducts or dives beneath the latter. Thrust zones run along the Kirthar, Sulaiman and Salt ranges. There are four faults in and around Karachi and other parts of deltaic Indus, and Makran coast. The first is the Allah Bund fault that passes through Shahbandar, Jah, Pakistan Steel Mills, and runs through eastern parts of the city and ends near Cape Monz. This fault, in fact, has caused extensive damage in the past many centuries in the deltaic areas. The destruction of Bhanbhor in the 13th century and damage to Shahbandar in 1896 were caused by this fault. The other one emanates from the Rann of Kutchh. The third one is the Pubb fault which ends into Arabian sea near Makran coast and the last one is located in the lower Dadu district near Surajani and falls in the vicinity of Karachi. Tsunamis or tidal waves have also affected the coast of Pakistan. The worst case was in 1945 when an earthquake of magnitude 8 struck the Makran coast, waves as high as 12 meters were reported. Let's not shallow our wit and wisdom and let us all realize the reality. It is the high time for humanity to come out of the fool's paradise and practice not only positive deeds but also technologies the world in an environment friendly manner so that we may come out of the whirlpool of crises.

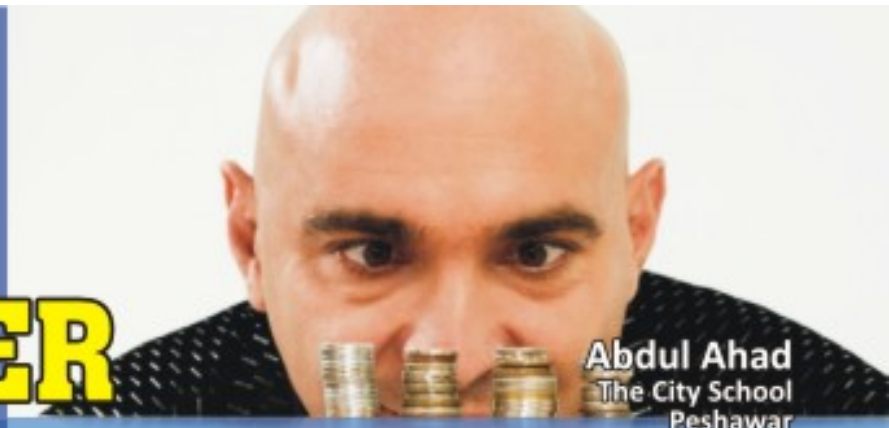

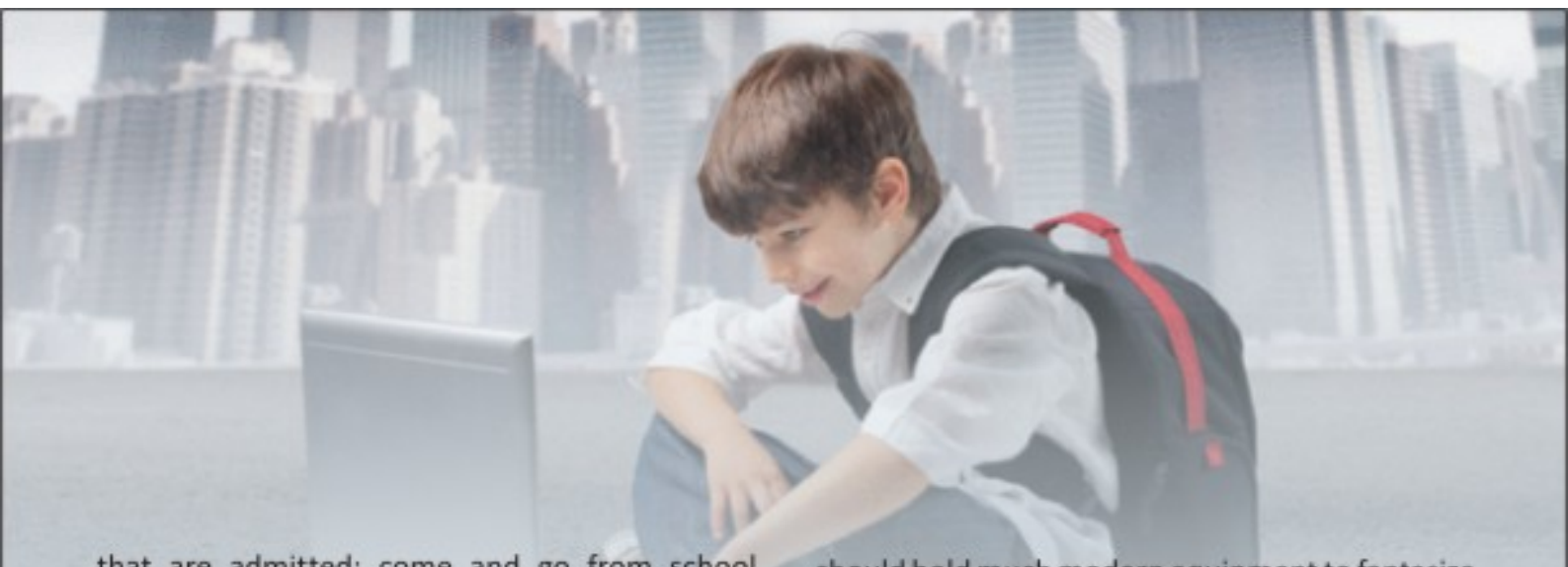

Villages, mostly, suffer from illiteracy as most parents regard education as an unnecessary facility that their children, especially daughters, would not require. Once youngsters finish their primary education they should be given admissions into universities based on their aptitudes. This way more people will strive harder as they will be ensured that once they grow up, they will not be the victim of a corrupt education system. Same rule should be applied when they opt for a professional life. They should receive jobs according to their qualifications only.

Furthermore in Pakistan the local education system should go through a thorough redemption so that people don't find the need to opt for expensive foreign courses. The curriculum needs to be reviewed so that children can receive scientific and secular education in their mother tongue. In addition, they need to develop critical and creative thinking. Use of unfair means should be strictly checked so that only meritorious people attain a degree.

The political conditions also need to be settled to ensure that students fly through their academic year with a sound mind and full security. The future depends on the youth and the youth depends on the education and thus if proper initiation and maintenance of these steps is overseen, soon Pakistan will witness an end of the education crisis.

FIGURES OF SPEECH

Figures of speech also known as figurative language is an important part of English Language. It adds humor and fun to our stories, articles, poems etc. Whenever you describe something by comparing it with something else, you are using figurative language. Any language that goes beyond the literal meaning of words in order to furnish new effects into an idea or a subject could be referred as figurative language. The most common figures of speech are similes, metaphors, hyperbole, onomatopoeia, alliterations, personification, idioms and etc. Let's discuss some of the above mentioned figures of speech.

SIMILIE

This is a figure of speech which involves a direct comparison of two unlike things usually with the words like or as.

Example: The muscles on his brawny arms are strong as iron bands.

IDIOMS

These provide us with a new way of looking at the world. Usually they come out of a popular places' culture that is why they are also called cultural metaphors.

Example: Round the clock means throughout the day.

Going nuts or bananas means going crazy. Butterfingers means clumsy or someone who often drops things.

One example sentence could be I'm going to go nuts/bananas if I don't get a job soon!

METAPHORS

It is a figure of speech which involves an implied

comparison between two relatively unlike things using a form of be, is or like.

Example: Time is money.

The internet is an information super highway.

ONOMATOPOEIA

Yes, I know it has a difficult yet funny name. It is pronounced as ONO-MA-TO-PEA-A. It is the use of words that mimic sound or when you name an action by imitating the sound associated with it, this is known as onomatopoeia.

Example: The fire cracker made a loud kaboom!
The bees buzz angrily when their hive is disturbed.
The train chugged down the hill.

Some words used for onomatopoeia are puff, boom, zoom, crash, pop, thud and bang.

HYPERBOLE

This figure of speech is as interesting as its name. It is pronounced as HI-PER-BOAL. It is an exaggerated statement used to heighten effect. It is not used to mislead the reader, but to emphasize a point.
Example: My eyes widened at the sight of the mile high ice cream.

It is so hot out here that I could melt.

PERSONIFICATION

This is a figure of speech in which an inanimate object can be personified by human qualities. In other words, whenever emotions, desires, sensations, physical gestures and speech are stated in context of non living things, personification has taken place. Through this

technique, we describe lifeless things as humans. The concept is often used in poetry where things are often described as having feelings. This figure of speech makes it easier to imagine a particular thing by creating a picture of it in the mind. It enables the reader to relate to a subject and imagine how a lifeless thing would have behaved.

Example: My computer hates me.

Time never waits for anyone.

The beam of light tiptoed into our classroom.

The radio sprang to life at the touch of a button.

The flowers begged for water.

The snow had wrapped white blankets over the city.

Personification of the wind:

We often see in poetry or write ups, wind being personified. It is one of the most common things

to be personified. Here are some phrases or sentences on the personification of wind. They may have been extracted from books or articles or poetry.

1.The wind whispered in my ears.

2.The wind's soft whisper was soothing.

3.The wind exploded into laughter as it hit the chimes.

4.The wind sang its melody.

5.The wind howled its mighty objection.

6.The wind bit me hard.

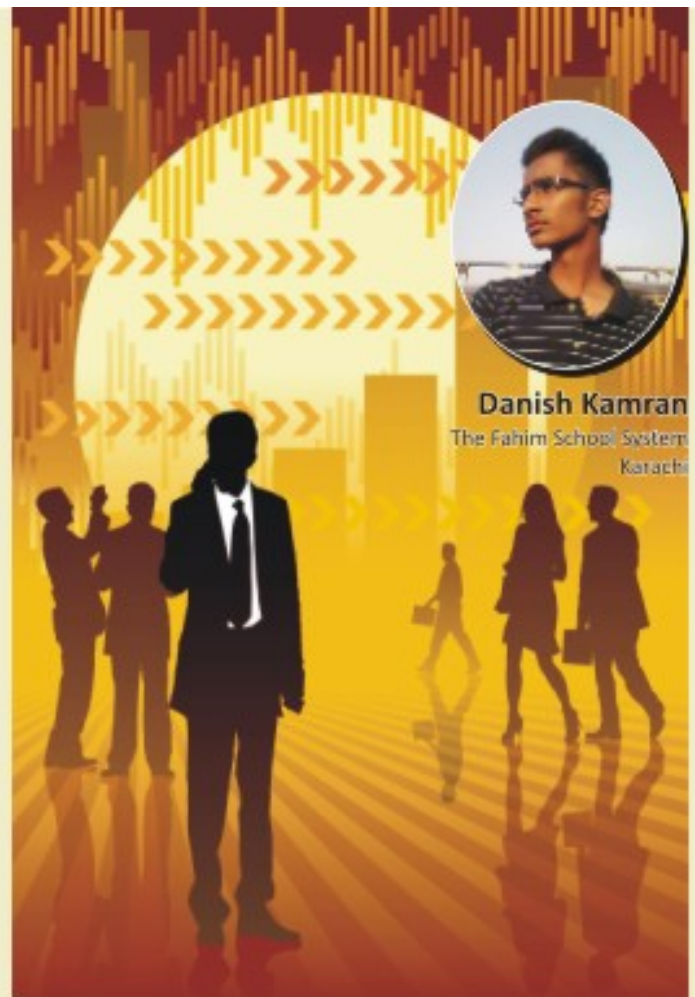
Health is a persons most prize possession. We don't really realize the true importance of it until we lose it. Health paves the way for success and wealth.

WAR ON TERRORISM HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THE GROWING ABUSE OF HUMAN RIGHTS

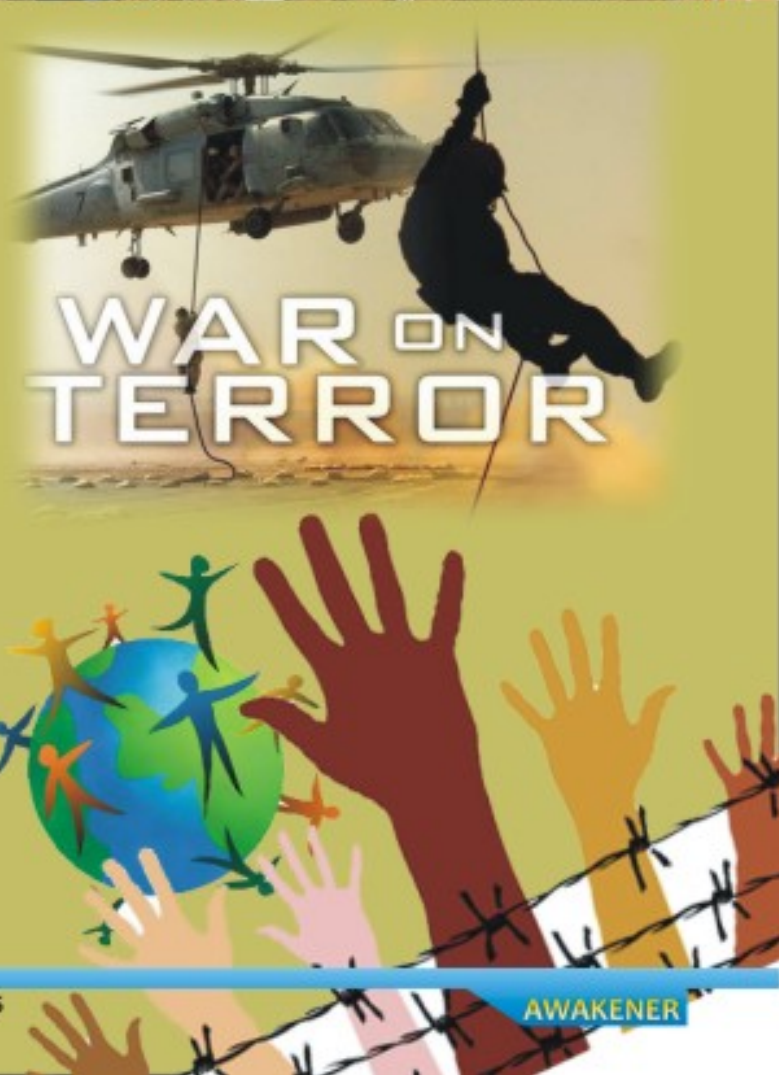

Human rights are relevant to terrorism as it concerns both its victims and its perpetrators. The innocent victims of war on terrorism suffer an attack on their most basic right, to live in peace and security.

Among many human rights abuse the war on terrorism, is taking away the right to own property. The armies bomb the personal properties of civilians with no cause except that they suspect terrorists' presence there. Homes, commercial buildings etc are seized to be used as army bases. Moreover, the educational system of the particular area is disturbed. Children cannot possibly go to school with fighter jets flying overhead. Furthermore, school buildings are targeted as possible hideouts of terrorists. Not only this, but medical facilities are also snatched from local population. Doctors are forced to work on injured

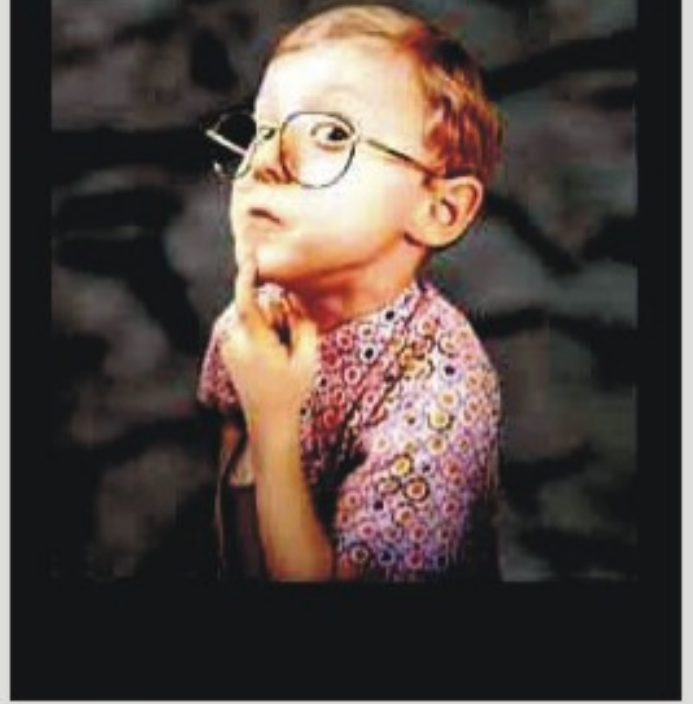

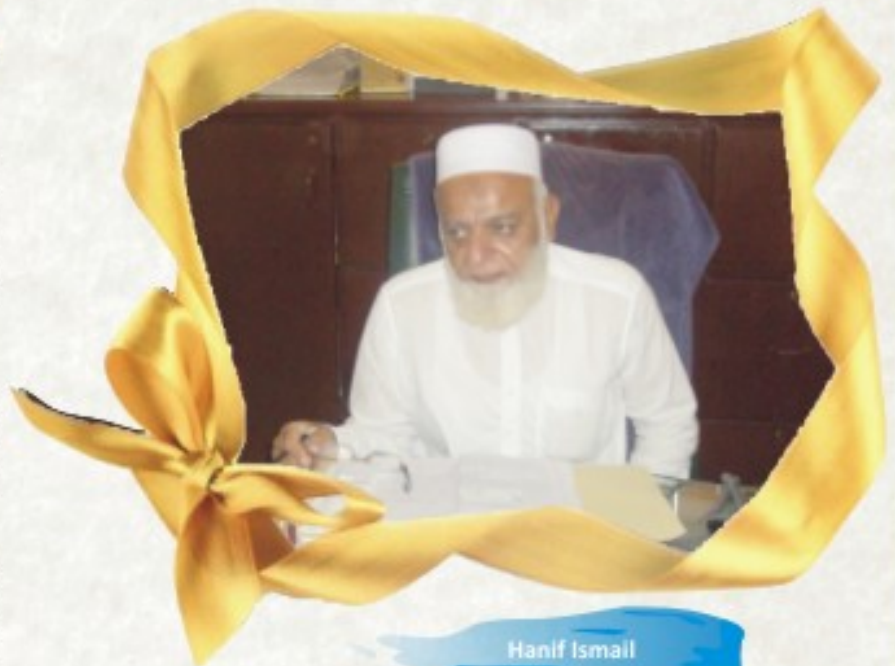

MOHAWKS:

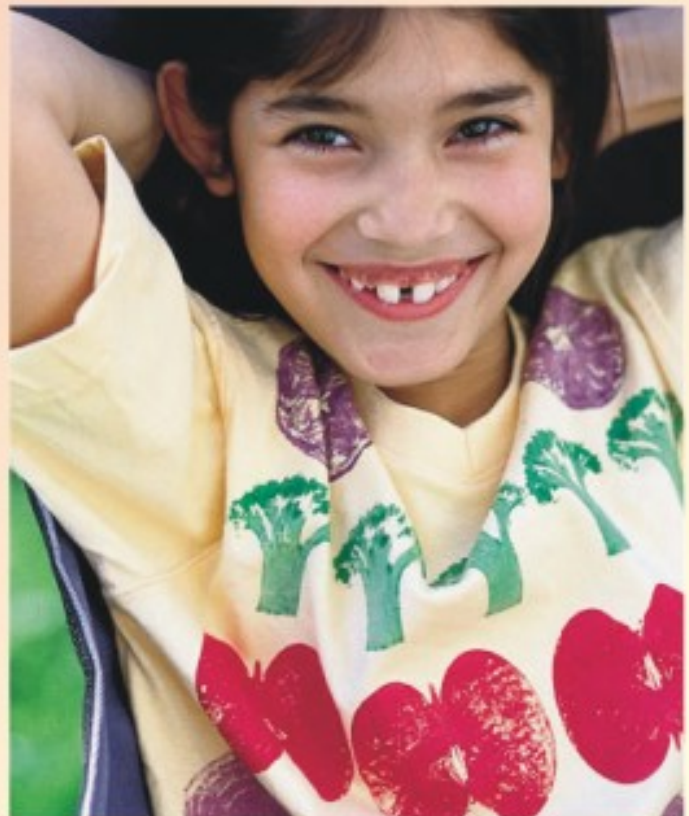

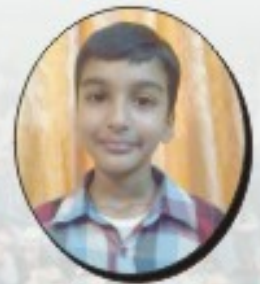
THE TIME MACHINE in the Golden Compass!!!

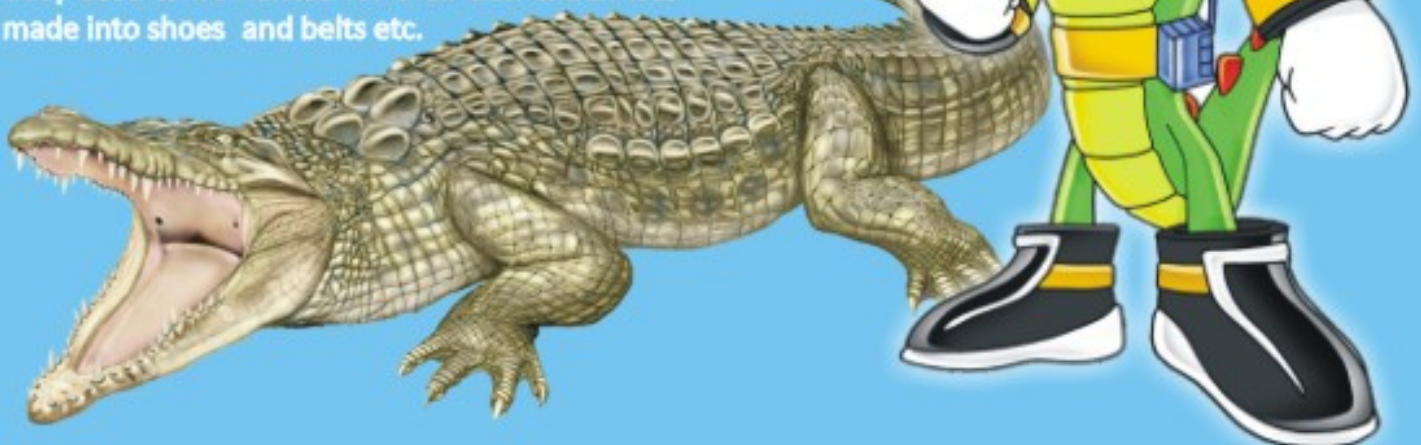
Crocodiles are large lizard like reptiles. They are cold blooded animals.

Snow leopards face threats from hunters, loss of habitat, and a decreased food supply. Researcher's estimate that between 4000 and 7000 snow leopards are left in the wild. In Pakistan, their number is between 200 and 420. People sometimes hunt wild sheep and goats that are the snow leopards main prey.

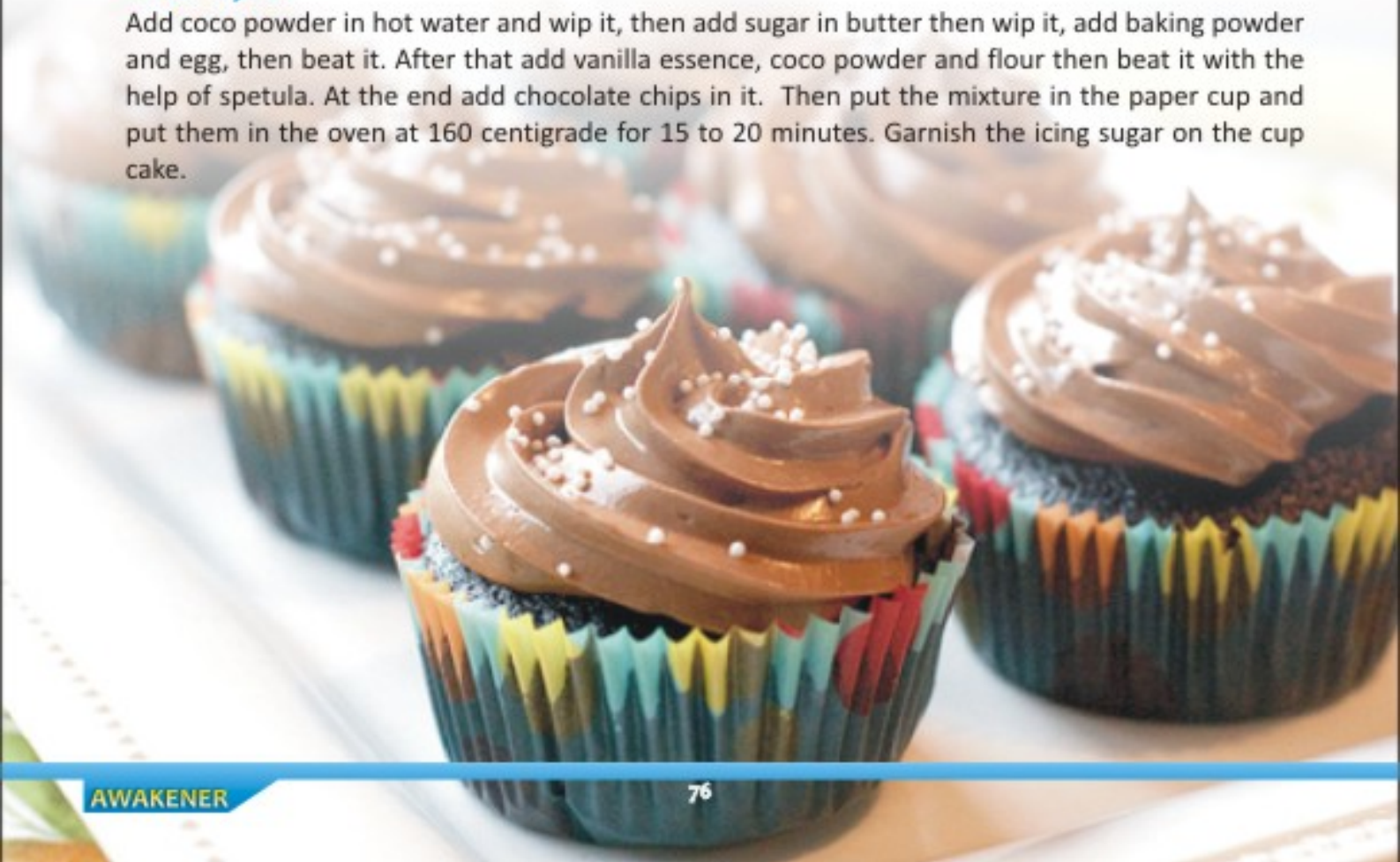
INGREDIENTS:

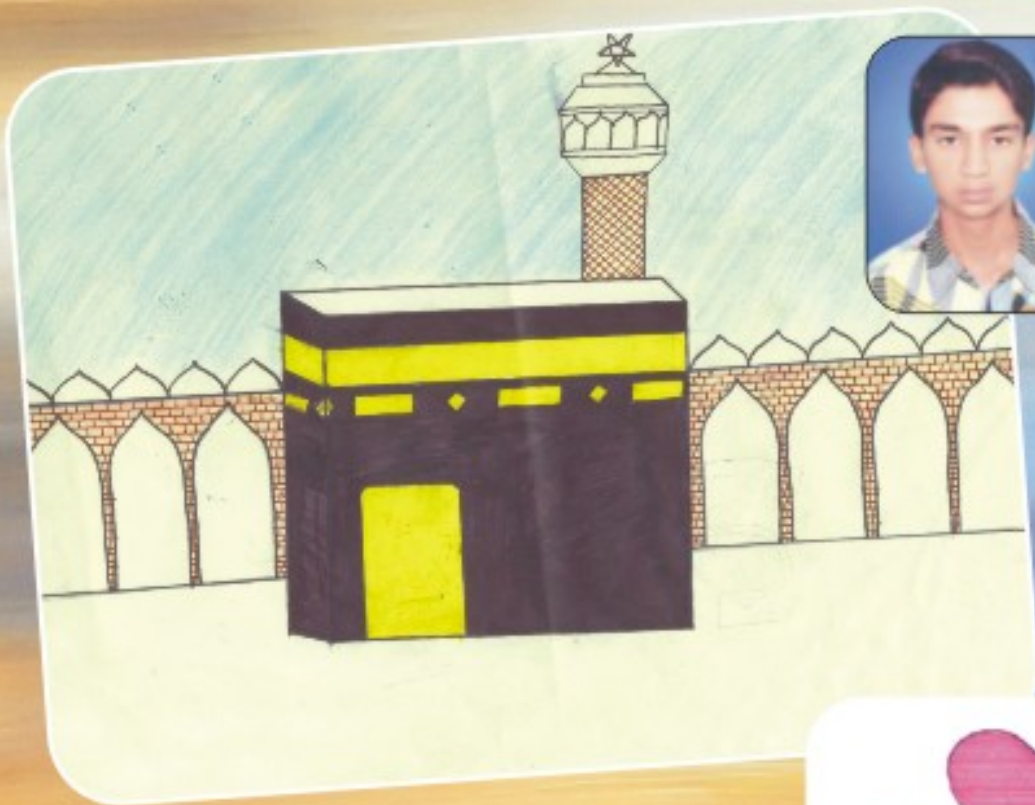

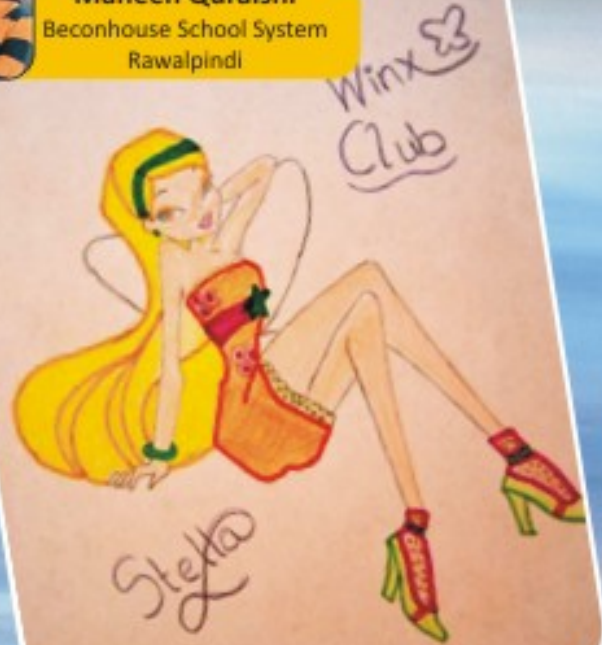

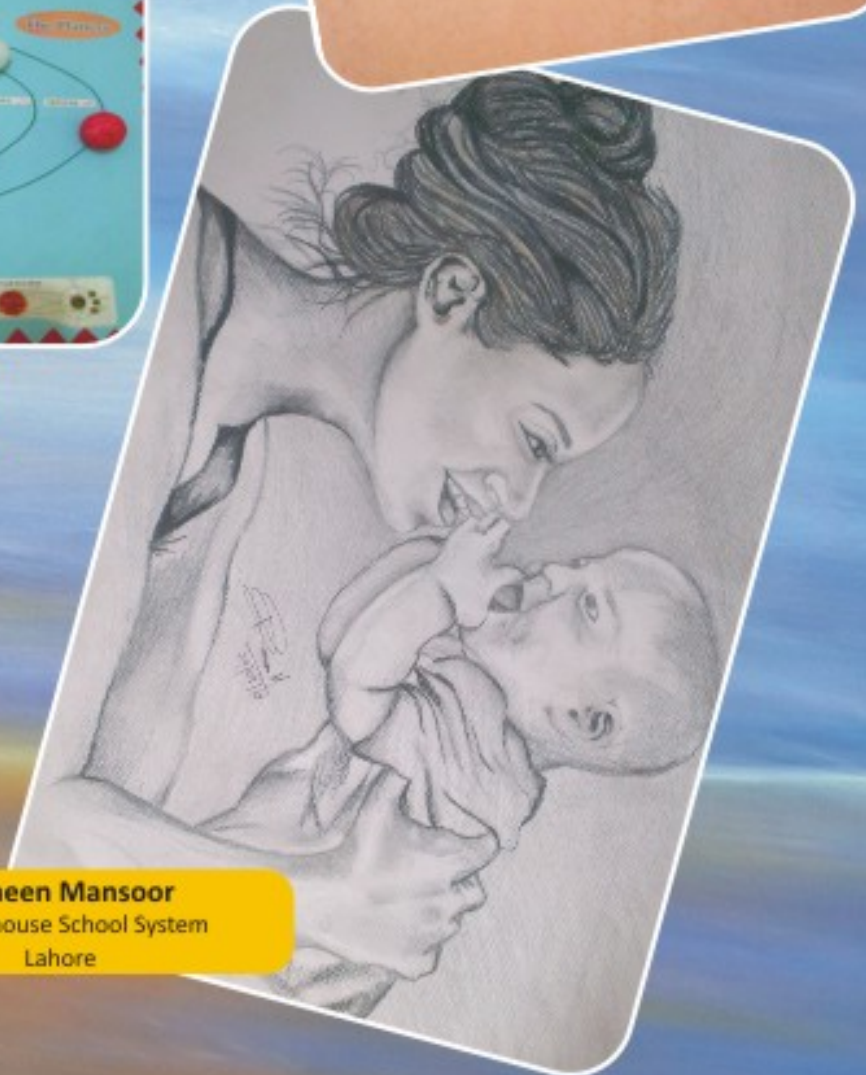
